Well Aggregation Permit

The permittee agrees to abide by the Rules, orders of the Board and Management Plan of the Bluebonnet Groundwater Conservation District, as amended, and the Rules, Regulations and Statutes of the State of Texas, as amended.

This permit confers only the right to aggregate the total amount of water withdrawn from the above listed wells. The permitted aggregate production is assigned to all the wells listed and each well is not allocated a prorated share or limited to its permitted production.

The application pursuant to which this permit has been issued is incorporated into this permit, which is being granted on the basis of, and contingent upon, the accuracy of the information supplied in that application. A finding that false information has been supplied is grounds for cancellation of this permit.

Violation of the permit's terms, condition, requirements, or special provisions is punishable by civil penalties as provided by the District Rules and by law. This permit confers no vested rights in the holder and the permit is non-transferable.

The permittee may be required to report the monthly production of water from each well included in this aggregation permit. Even though individual well production limits may be exceeded, a violation of permitted production will only occur if the permitted aggregated production is exceeded.

The issuance of this permit does not grant the permittee the right to use private property not under his control, or public property, for the production or conveyance of water. Neither does this permit authorize the invasion of personal rights nor the violation of federal, state, or local laws or regulations.

The District makes no representation and shall have no responsibility with respect to the availability or quality of water authorized to be produced under this permit.

This permit shall expire thirty (30) years from the date of issuance. The permittee must apply to the District for a permit renewal at least sixty (60) days prior to the expiration date of this permit.
